**REMINDER: WOODBINE HOLIDAY PARADE  
SET FOR FRIDAY DECEMBER 7**

Please join with the Borough of Woodbine in celebrating the upcoming holiday season when on Friday, December 7, the Borough hosts its annual holiday parade, sponsored by the Woodbine Volunteer Fire Company.

The parade will begin at 6 p.m. and line up will start at 5 p.m. on Bryant Street east of Washington Avenue.

The parade route will be the same as on previous years, from Bryant south on Washington to Clay Street, east on Clay to Heilprin Avenue, and north on Heilprin to DeHirsch Avenue to the Firehouse.

As is the local tradition, Santa and the Mayor will partner to light the Christmas Tree on the bikepath. The evening then concludes at the Firehouse where refreshments will be served and trophies awarded. Santa will also be there to visit with the children.
