WOODBINE MAYOR ISSUES GENERAL AVIATION MONTH PROCLAMATION

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky, at the May 3 Borough Council meeting, will issue a Proclamation declaring May as “General Aviation Appreciation Month” in the Borough of Woodbine, and invites all citizens to recognize the importance of local community airports.
