

Dear Mayor Pikolycky,

The New Jersey Department of Transportation will be fabricating and installing scenic byway identification signs along the **Pine Barrens Byway**. This includes the signs located within NJDOT Right of Way and also the signs located within County, Municipal or some other governmental agency's Right of Way. All signs located outside of the limits of the NJDOT jurisdiction will be required to have signed agreements in place before installation can occur. Please review the enclosed agreement for signature.

Byways showcase New Jersey's scenic, natural and historic places, and draw visitors to come and enjoy all the great places along these byways. Byway visitors can bring dollars to byway communities – an important benefit of designation. Installing byway marker signs is key to bringing people to byways and helping them to more easily and safely follow the routes. Byway signs announce the roadway's special designation to the public. NJDOT, the County, and local roadway jurisdictions play an important role in signing the Byways.

A disk copy of the sign location plans which were approved by NJDOT for compliance with the Federal Highway Administration's **Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices** is also included in this correspondence. Call me with any questions you might have about either the plans or the agreement. Since NJDOT will be installing all of the signs please notify me if adjustments need to be made with any of the locations. If no changes are required to the agreement, please return two signed originals to me as soon as possible (included in package).
