WOODBINE FEATURED IN CROSS COUNTY CONNECTION MAGAZINE

In an article entitled "Complete Streets: Lessons Learned" it was noted how Woodbine has continued to build upon its "already expansive bicycle and pedestrian network" and that "It is hoped that these projects in... Woodbine Will inspire interested communities to adopt a Complete Streets policy and encourage those that already have policies to start implementing projects."

Woodbine adopted its Complete Streets Policy in 2012, one of the first municipalities in Cape May County to do so.

It has applied these principles in formulating design for safe streets Boroughwide. This has enhanced the competiveness of the Borough's applications for State and Federal Transportation grants.

Woodbine was also cited in another article in this issue for its Safe Routes to Schools Travel plan, which was featured in an article in the Spring 2013 issue. In the Spring 2014 issue, "EASYrider" reported that Woodbine received a Silver certificate award for its Safe Routes Program.

"Cross County Connection provides Woodbine with the knowledge and expertise to position itself to obtain the necessary funding to make these health and safety projects a reality for all our residents, and especially our school children," added Mayor Pikolycky.
