FREEHOLDERS TO PRESENT JOINT VENTURE CHECK TO WOODBINE

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Freeholders will be presenting a check in the amount of \$50,000 from the Cape May County 2007 Municipal Public Improvements Joint Venture Program at the recently completed Woodbine Community/School Recreational Complex at the Woodbine Elementary School at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, September 12.

“As the new school year opens, the Freeholders will get their first opportunity to tour this facility to which they were a contributing partner this year as well as last year through the Joint Venture Program. We hope to take this opportunity to showcase not only the Recreation Complex but also the soon-to-be opened Woodbine branch of the Cape May County Library system,” added Mayor Pikolycky. “I thank the Board of Chosen Freeholders for recognizing the importance of this project that will benefit the entire community. The new complex also includes a Community/School library and technology center. The Borough is planning an official dedication ceremony of the new complex sometime in October.”
