### **WOODBINE TO RECEIVE CAPE MAY COUNTY MUA RECYCLING REBATE**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine will receive a 2012 recycling rebate in the amount of \$2,719.30 from the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority (CMCMUA).

Rebates are apportioned to municipalities based upon the tons of recyclables delivered to the CMCMUA's Intermediate Processing Facility (IPF) for processing during 2012. The recycling rebates are in addition to the savings represented by avoiding the landfill tip fee for every ton recycled.

“Woodbine 2012 IPF was based upon receipt of 196.60 tons of recyclable materials. Upping our percentage of recycled matter would increase next year's rebate, which has been made easier by the broadening of items that now can be included as part of recent change-over to single-stream recycling, where everything to be recycled can be placed into one recycling container,” added Mayor Pikolycky, “ For more information visit [www.cmcmua.com](http://www.cmcmua.com) or call 465-9026.”
