**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky announces that the Borough of Woodbine will hold a Public Hearing on July 19 at 3:30 p.m. at the Woodbine Municipal Services Building, 501 Washington Avenue. The subject of the hearing will be to receive public comments and support concerning the proposed submission of a New Jersey Department of Community Affairs Small Cities Public Facilities grant application requesting funding in the amount of \$400,000 to install a new municipal well and to upgrade all Borough recreation facilities such as parks and ballfields.

The hearing will explain federal and state guidelines, review eligible and proposed program activities, discuss the current proposal, and receive citizen comments and recommendations.

All citizens are encouraged to attend and offer comments either at the Public Hearing or in writing addressed either to the Mayor at the Borough Hall or to the Department of Community Affairs, Grant Development and Contract Administration Unit, PO Box 811, Trenton, NJ 08625-0811.

“We want to thank the Department of Community Affairs who have recently provided us with \$600,000, \$400,00 for improvements at the Community School Complex and \$200,00 for another round of housing rehabilitation, which is now getting underway,” added Mayor Pikolycky.
