### **CAPE ASSIST TO PROVIDE PAAD INFORMATION AT WOODBINE COMMUNITY CENTER**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that a representative from Cape Assist will be available at the Woodbine Community Center, 812 Longfellow, Woodbine, on August 15, from 9:30 to 2:30 to assist seniors in filling out the forms for PAAD (government pharmaceutical assistance.)

Attention: New Jersey Residents, 65 years or older, or at least 18 years of age and receiving Social Security Disability benefits with an annual income in 2015 less than \$26,757 (single) and \$32,582 (married). Qualifying applicants will receive coverage for prescribed legend drugs, insulin and insulin supplies; co-pays will be \$5 for PAAD covered generic drugs and \$7 for PAAD covered name brands.
