WOODBINE TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON CABLE CONCERNS

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine will be conducting a Public Hearing on Thursday, May 2, 2013 at 6 p.m. at the Borough Hall, 501 Washington Avenue, Woodbine, New Jersey.

This Hearing will be held for the purpose of evaluating the application of Comcast of South Jersey, LLC, for the renewal of its municipal consent to own, operate, extend and maintain a cable television and cable communications system in the Borough of Woodbine and is held in accordance with N.J.S.A. 48:5A-23 and N.J.A.C. 14:18-11.6, and all other applicable statutory and regulatory provisions.

All interested parties are invited to attend and be heard with respect to this application. Copies of the application will be on file with the Borough Clerk and can be reviewed Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the Borough Hall.
