WOODBINE TO APPLY TO DCA FOR \$700,000 IN GRANT FUNDING

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that Woodbine Borough Council has approved that two applications be made to the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for grant funding totaling \$700,000.

The first application will be for the Housing Rehabilitation program, with a request of \$200,000.

The second application, with a request of \$500,000, is to the Small Cities Public Facilities program. Possible projects are capital improvements to the Woodbine School, capital improvements to the recreational parks, and improvements to the Firehouse.

A Public Hearing will be held on August 20, 2009, at 3:30 p.m. at the Municipal Building, to discuss these applications.

“This comes on the heels of the completion of our present Housing Rehabilitation grant cycle, which rehabbed approximately thirteen homes. The application at hand would rehab up to eleven homes,” added Mayor Pikolycky.
