WOODBINE APPLIES TO DCA FOR HOUSING REHABILITATION FUNDING

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has made application to the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs Small Cities Housing Rehabilitation Program for grant funding in the amount of \$200,000 to rehabilitate approximately ten owner-occupied homes in the Borough.

The Borough of Woodbine would utilize these funds to assist low- and moderate-income families to upgrade their Woodbine homes to local code. The Borough has previously participated in several Housing Rehabilitation grants.

Award announcements are expected from DCA before the new year.

“This comes on the heels of our Neighborhood Stabilization program which is permitting the Borough to rehab an additional six properties, which will then be purchased by income-eligible families and returned to our tax base,” added Mayor Pikolycky. “This current application would further enable the Borough to continue its housing rehab program to improve community health and safety.
