Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine adopted a resolution at its August 16 Council meeting authorizing three separate applications to the New Jersey Department of Transportation Division of Local Aid for grant funding for projects for road surfacing, roadway reconstruction, and drainage totaling approximately \$470,000.

These three applications call for addressing seven streets/blocks throughout the community.

“Maintaining our roadways and infrastructure has been a priority of the Borough. If these applications prove successful, it would place our roadway program at an all-time level. Once again I note that without this transportation infrastructure funding, of which the Borough has received millions of dollars throughout the years, these improvements could not have been made without increasing the burden of local property taxes. Word from DOT on the current applications is expected toward latter part of the year,” noted Mayor Pikolycky. “We are presently administering two DOT-funded projects that are under construction and nearing completion which total \$300,000.”
