### **WOODBINE GOING OUT TO BID FOR GENERATOR PROJECT**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has authorized going out to bid for the purchase and installation of a New Emergency Generator for the Woodbine Municipal Building.

Sealed bids will be received, opened, and read on July 7 at 10 a.m. at the Woodbine Borough Hall.

Copies of contract documents may be obtained only from the office of the Borough Engineer upon presentation of the name and mailing address of the interested party and the payment of a non-refundable charge of \$50 for reproduction and processing. Checks shall be made payable to Van Note-Harvey Associates, P.C.

Funding for this was received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency through the State Hazard Mitigation Office New Jersey Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$75,000.

“This project will provide the ability for Borough Emergency Management Personnel to continue to operate during power outages in major storm events”, stated Mayor Pikolycky.
