In doing so, they help reduce the amount of fertilizer and pesticides that are carried offsite by stormwater runoff and thus work towards preventing nonpointsource pollution in our lakes, rivers, and streams," commented Mayor Pikolycky. "Come join the Green Team in a fun and educational activity."
