WOODBINE FILES APPLICATIONS FOR FORMER HAT FACTORY SITE REMEDIATION PROJECT TOTALING \$80,992.88

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has made an application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund (HDSRF) for funding additional environmental investigation at the former Hat Company Site located at the intersection of Adams Avenue and DeHirsch Avenue.

The Site was the location of the former Woodbine Hat Company which began operation in 1918 and then the Bradstone Rubber and Adhesives Co. which operated until the 1960's. Fire destroyed the structures in the early 1980's and the site is currently vacant and ready for development.

The current application would fund a fourth phase of the remedial investigation under the New Jersey Site Remediation Program. The amount requested in this new phase is \$80,992.88. Taylor Wiseman & Taylor of Mount Laurel, NJ has prepared the technical application for the investigative work at the Site.

“This funding, if approved, will give the Borough a completed remedial investigation for the site enabling the Borough to restore this property to the tax roles as a commercial use” noted Mayor Pikolycky.
