WOODBINE FILES APPLICATIONS FOR SITE REMEDIATION PROJECTS TOTALING \$375,000

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has made application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund (HDSRF) for two site remediation projects.

The first site is on the Woodbine Municipal Airport property, and is in reference to multi-areas of concern from previous commercial and military uses, including the old ammunition bunkers.

The amount requested is \$152,009.

The second site is the former Foundations and Structures landfill on Fidler Hill Road for additional work to continue the groundwater monitoring and on-going site investigation.

The amount requested is \$223,025.

“If funding is approved, this will give us a final closure action plan for these two locations,” noted Mayor Pikolycky.
