WOODBINE RECEIVES \$175,319 FOR SITE REMEDIATION PROJECT

Woodbine— Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has received funding through the Department of Environmental Protection Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund (HDSRF) in the amount of \$175,319 for additional remediation work at the former Foundations and Structures landfill on Fidler Hill Road to continue groundwater monitoring and on-going site investigation.

“The purpose of this additional funding would be to install and test additional monitoring wells in order for the Borough more strongly position ourselves to make the property available for re-development,” added Mayor Pikolycky. “I want to thank the EDA for approving our request to continue to address this potential site remediation at our Redevelopment Zone.”
