This class will focus primarily on painting bird houses that have already been assembled. Participants are required to bring their own brushes including a ½-inch angle brush, a fine liner brush, and a #1 round brush.

Presenter Betty Tocci has been a practitioner of many different types of crafts for most of her life. She found she needed to learn how to do a variety of different crafting when her husband built a store at their bison ranch and needed unique things to sell. This knowledge has made her well-rounded in many different forms of art.
