### **WIRE & BEAD EARRING WORKSHOP AT WOODBINE BRANCH OF CMC LIBRARY**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Library will be holding an adult arts and crafts program to create a pair of custom earrings using wire and beads at the Woodbine Branch, located at 800 Monroe Street, Woodbine, on Thursday, September 25, from 4 to 6 pm.

With a bit of imagination and ingenuity, transform raw materials into a wearable work of art. The workshop will focus on wire bending techniques, light hammering, and making the custom ear wires. Earring size can be made smaller according to preference.

Presenter Adrienne Barge, from Lower Township, has been creating and selling jewelry at local shops and festivals for fourteen years. Adrienne is semi-retired and living the bohemian life.

A non-refundable \$8.00 materials fee will be charged at time of registration. In order to participate in this workshop participants are required to bring in their own jewelry tools. Tools required include sharp or chain nosed jewelry pliers, round nosed jewelry pliers, and a wire cutter.
