WOODBINE TO RECEIVE MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE FUNDS

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Department of Human Services has informed Woodbine that the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse has approved its 2009 Municipal Alliance application in the amount of \$15,000.

This funding includes a cash match the of \$1,875 and an in-kind match of \$5,625, both provided by the Borough, along with DEDR (State) funds in the amount of \$7,500.
