WOODBINE TO RECEIVE MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE FUNDS

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Department of Human Services has informed Woodbine that it is eligible to apply for FY 2015-2016 Municipal Alliance funding from the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA).

Prospective funding consists of a cash match of \$1,375 and an in-kind match of \$4,125, which are provided by the Borough, along with DEDR (State) funds in the amount of \$5,500, for a total grant of \$11,000.

"As we submit our renewal grant application for this funding, the Borough continues to partner to provide substance abuse awareness programs for our community as a whole," commented Mayor Pikolycky. "We are looking at ways to continue leveraging this funding into programs that will best provide these benefits, given the reductions that the State and County have been forced to make in these much appreciated fundings.
