**WOODBINE CONTINUES TO RECEIVE MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE FUNDS**

**Woodbine-** Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Department of Human Services has informed the Woodbine Municipal Alliance that the Governor's Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse (GCADA) has approved the Alliance for a grant totaling \$12,125.

This funding consists of a cash match of \$1,516 and an in-kind match of \$4,547, both provided by the Borough, along with DEDR (State) funds in the amount of \$6,062 , for a total grant of \$12,124.

I am pleased to see our Alliance again funded for the upcoming year. Most recently, the Alliance partnered with the Woodbine Recreation Commission to bring two stress-management seminars to our Seniors at the Community Center, commented Mayor Pikolycky. As we look at ways to continue leveraging this funding into programs that will best provide these benefits, given the reductions that the State and County have been forced to make in these much appreciated fundings, I emphasize that the support of volunteers is needed to continue the Committee's work.
