### **WOODBINE CONTINUES TO RECEIVE MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE FUNDS**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Department of Human Services has informed the Woodbine Municipal Alliance that the Governor's Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse (GCADA) has approved the Alliance for a grant totaling \$11,000.

This funding consists of a DEDR (State) funds in the amount of \$5,500, municipal cash match of \$1,375, and an in-kind match of \$4,125, both provided by the Borough, for a total grant of \$11,000.
