MIDATLANTIC MEDEVAC HOLDS GRAND OPENING OF NEW FACILITY AT WOODBINE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that Med-Trans dba MidAtlantic Medevac held the Grand Opening of its Woodbine base of operations at the Woodbine Municipal Airport on October 25, 2016.

MidAtlantic MedEvac has been operating at the Woodbine Municipal Airport for the last approximately 5 years and is owned by Med-Trans. Med-Trans and AtlantiCare teams make up the staff at the base and work in concert to provide rapid medical response and transport by air. MedEvac 4 operates an Airbus EC 135 helicopter with a crew of three.

The new base, a modular office, took over a year to become operational. Med-Trans wants to thank the Woodbine Municipal Airport, Woodbine Port Authority, the Mayor's Office, and the Borough of Woodbine for their invaluable assistance in making this happen. They thank also the engineering firm of Engineering Design Associates, especially Chris Carey, for spearheading the project.
