WOODBINE AWARDS CONTRACT FOR COUNTY LIBRARY BRANCH ACCESS ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND PARKING

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has awarded the contract for its Monroe Avenue road reconstruction project. The New Jersey Department of Transportation has given the Borough of Woodbine a Municipal Aid grant in the amount of \$143,000 for this project, a continuation of a project previously funded by NJDOT, the project totaling \$375,000.

The contract has been awarded to Jerry & Son Excavation, Inc., of Mays Landing, who was low bidder with a proposal in the amount of \$134,068.85, which included the base bid and alternates 2 and 3.

Monroe Avenue will be improved for 600 feet south of Webster as well the drainage system.

This reconstruction will be the last phase of the Woodbine Community/School project.

Monroe Avenue will provide road primary access and parking facilities for the new addition and will be a staging area for any buses that may be needed at the school for field trips, sports, etc. In addition, many residents including students will utilize this route to access both only the sports complex in the rear of the school as well the school's main entrance.

"A total of eleven grants/entities were involved as funding stakeholders for the Community/School project, bringing the project to a total of \$4 million," noted Mayor Pikolycky. "A pre-construction has been scheduled for April 19."
