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BOROUGH OF WOODBINE TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING TO REVIEW SMALL CITIES GRANT

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine will hold a public hearing on October 3, 2018, at 4 pm in the Borough Council meeting room at 501 Washington Avenue, Woodbine, NJ.

The purpose of this hearing is to review the performance of and receive citizen comments and recommendations concerning the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant awarded in 2018 for Public Facilities.

The Borough of Woodbine received a grant in the amount of \$400,000 from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for the purchase of a new fire pumper truck for use by the Woodbine Volunteer Fire Department.

The new pumper will replace an existing 22-year-old pumper that, according to National Fire Protection Act (NFPA) standards, has reached the end of its useful life and no longer meets safety standards.

“Thanks to both New Jersey Department of Community Affairs and United States Department of Agriculture-Rural Development for showing their commitment to Woodbine’s needs through providing the funding, which between the two totaled approximately \$450,000, for the purchase of this necessary piece of equipment,” added Mayor Pikolycky.
