### **WOODBINE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT RECEIVES SAFETY IMPROVEMENT FUNDING**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Woodbine Municipal Airport has received funding from the New Jersey of Transportation Airport Improvement/Airport Safety Fund Program for Runway Safety Area Improvements in the amount of \$166,250.

This funding will be used for Runway Safety Area Improvements on the Runway 31 end. This will complete the reconstruction work on this runway by improving the “trapezoid safety area”.
