WOODBINE RECEIVES \$500,000 FROM NJDCA

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has been awarded by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs Small Cities Public Facilities program grant funding in the amount of \$500,000.

There are two major components to this award:

The first is for replacement of Borough Well #7. The installation of this new municipal well will ensure adequate public water for the community and its residential and commercial properties, as well as for the Woodbine Developmental Center Complex.

The second component is to improve upon the Borough's various outdoor recreational facilities that are in need of upgrades to today's standards and regulations.

"Replacement of this well will now ensure the ongoing health and safety of our residents and businesses," added Mayor Pikolycky. "The funding for improvement of our outdoor recreational facilities will continue this health-related initiative that has included the recent construction of the Community School gymnasium for indoor activities. I wish to again thank the Department of Community Affairs and Senator Van Drew and Assemblymen Albano and Milam for all their continuing support of Woodbine's ongoing improvements."
