WOODBINE HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON WATER TOWER RENOVATION FUNDING

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine will hold a Public Hearing on July 30, 2013 at 5:30 p.m., in the main meeting room of the municipal services building, 501 Washington Avenue, Woodbine, NJ 08270.

The purpose of this hearing is as follows: (1) to explain federal and state guidelines relating to the Small Cities Program administered by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs; (2) to review eligible and proposed program activities; (3) to consider proposals for an application under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program; and (4) to receive citizen comments and recommendations.

The Borough of Woodbine is considering the submission of a Public Facilities Application for \$400,000 for renovation of the Woodbine Municipal Utility Authority's Water Tower,
