WOODBINE RECEIVES DOT MUNICIPAL AID FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$174,000 FOR ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has received funding in the amount of \$174,000 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid program for the Reconstruction of Scott Avenue.

This reconstruction of Scott Avenue is from DeHirsch Boulevard (County Route 550) to Freidriechstadt Avenue. The project would include construction of curbing, concrete apron, storm drainage improvements, milling and paving the street, and topsoil and seed restoration.

“Scott Avenue serves as an access route between a heavily traveled corridor, DeHirsch Boulevard/County Route 550, and commercial and residential zones,” noted Mayor Pikolycky. “NJDOT has again shown its commitment to assistance to local governments for such improvements to local transportation networks in communities such as ours.”
