WOODBINE AWARDS CONTRACT FOR SCOTT AVENUE FOR ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine at its June 17 Council meeting awarded a contract for road reconstruction for Scott Avenue to South State Inc., Bridgeton.

This reconstruction of Scott Avenue is from DeHirsch Boulevard (County Route 550) to Freidriechstadt Avenue. Scott Avenue serves as an access route to our major industrial/commercial complex. This access route is a heavily traveled corridor for large vehicles. The project would include construction of curbing, concrete apron, storm drainage improvements, milling and paving the street, and topsoil and seed restoration.

Funding in the amount of \$174,000 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid program was awarded for this project.

“This will also provide more exposure for expanding our industrial park, which just saw the opening of a brand new facility, Paraco Gas, one of the largest propane company distributors,” noted Mayor Pikolycky. “Construction is expected to be started in July.”
