TOYS FOR TOTS CHANGES REGISTRATION/DISTRIBUTION PROCESS

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Marine Corps Reserve Cape May County Toys for Tots has changed their registration and distribution process.

Applications and toy distribution will now take place at the same time, at their new location in The Enterprise Business Center, 28 Indian Trail Road, Burleigh (across from Home Depot).

Application and distribution will take place from December 14 to 23 from 2 to 7 pm.

Parents/legal guardians will need a photo ID of themselves and one proof of custody for each child (birth certificate, school ID, immunization record, or legal custody documents.) No exceptions will be made to this policy.
