### **WOODBINE CONTINUES TO BE RANKED AMONG MUNICIPALITIES WITH LOWEST TAXES IN STATE AND COUNTY**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky reported that on February 20, 2021, NJ Advance Media for NJ.com included an article from Samantha Marcus which reported that, although New Jersey property taxes reached a new high of an average of \$9,112, Woodbine's average property tax bill was only \$1,985, a mere increase of \$22 over the previous year, making it the third lowest in the State.

"We are pleased to see Woodbine again acknowledged for this accomplishment in the State-wide media, comparing our Borough to other municipalities" added Mayor Pikolycky. "This accomplishment could not have been achieved without using good fiscal management and best practices, especially during this time of flat municipal State funding."
