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CONTRACT AWARDED FOR WOODBINE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT HELICOPTER PARKING APRON PROJECT

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine awarded a contract for the Woodbine Municipal Airport Helicopter Parking Apron project at its June 21, 2018, Council meeting

The contract, in the amount of \$340,888.70, was awarded to South State, Inc.

Woodbine Municipal Airport is developing a designated helicopter parking area to provide adequate separation between fixed and rotary wing parking areas. The proposed helicopter parking area will provide two parking spaces that will support the design helicopter S-76. It will be a rectangular paved asphalt and concrete surface measuring approximately 11,725 SF.

“We have experienced an increase in demand for rotorcraft parking, which has become an additional revenue source. As a result, we are expanding our airport operations to become more user-friendly to helicopter operations while at the same time maintaining the safety of our single wing aircraft, and this project will bring us closer to our goal,” explained Mayor Pikolycky. “Funding is being provided by both the Federal Aviation Administration and New Jersey Department of Transportation, Division of Aeronautics.”
