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### **BID OPENINGS SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 23**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that Woodbine Borough Council, at their September 3, meeting, authorized going out for bids for two major projects, with bid openings scheduled for September 23, 2009.

The first is for replacement of Borough Well #7. The installation of this new municipal well will ensure adequate public water for the community and its residential and commercial properties, as well as for the Woodbine Developmental Center Complex.

The second component is to improve upon the Borough's various outdoor recreational facilities in Lincoln Park that are in need of upgrades to today's standards and regulations.

Funding, in the amount of \$500,000, divided between these two projects, was awarded by the Department of Community Affairs Small Cities Public Facilities Program.

The bids for the Lincoln Park work will be opened at 10 a.m.  
Bids for the well replacement will be opened at 10:30 a.m.

"Without this funding, these projects would not have been feasible without an increased tax burden," noted Mayor Pikolycky. "Once again we thank DCA for recognizing Woodbine's needs."
