WOODBINE COMMUNITY CELEBRATES ROCKING READING (ALONG WITH DR. SEUSS –AND WOODBINE’S—BIRTHDAYS)

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to wish a Happy 109th Birthday to Dr. Seuss—along with a Happy 110th to the Borough of Woodbine.

As the students and teachers at Woodbine Elementary School celebrated “Read Across America”, an annual event both honoring Dr. Seuss (aka Theodor Seuss Geisel) and encouraging reading on March 4, the Borough again commemorated the anniversary of its incorporation, which occurred on March 3, 1903.

This year’s theme is based on “Pete the Cat Rocking in My School Shoes” by Eric Litwin.

Students performed the “Rocking in My School Shoes Song”, which kicked off the reading incentive theme “Rockin Readers Challenge.”

Sixth, seventh, and eighth graders will share-read with the pre-K through third grade students.

Mayor Pikolycky presented a gift of a Dr. Seuss puzzle and a bird’s nest from his house, along with a DVD about spring, bird’s nests, and trees to the kindergarten class to promote learning about the environment as Spring approaches. He was presented with a certificate of participation for being a guest reader.

“Dr. Seuss books and other learning materials provide teachers with an extra tool that students enjoy to learn with,” notes Mayor Pikolycky.
