WOODBINE AWARDED CLEAN COMMUNITIES FUNDING

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that Governor Christies has announced that Woodbine has been awarded a \$7,218.39 2013 New Jersey Clean Communities grant from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

Woodbine has received over \$50,000 from this program over the past twenty years that it has been implemented.

The Clean Communities grants are funded by a fee imposed on manufacturers, wholesalers, and distributors of litter-generating products. Disbursements to municipalities are based on the number of housing units and miles of municipally-owned roadways within each municipality. Disbursements to counties are based on the number of miles of roads each county owns.

“This funding provides us an avenue for keeping our clean communities programs sustainable, while not placing an added burden upon our taxpayers,” added Mayor Pikolycky.
