Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that The New Jersey Department of Environmental Affairs has informed the Borough of Woodbine that its 2008 Clean Communities entitlement is \$4,379.11. To date Woodbine has received over \$35,000 from this program over the past several years.

Twenty-one counties and five hundred fifty-nine municipalities are eligible to receive the Clean Communities Funding during 2008. The amount of the entitlement is calculated based on a total of \$14.5 million in anti-litter fees collected as of March 2008. Woodbine's share is based on its proportionate share of housing units and municipal road mileage.

“These funds come at a good time when our municipal budgets are challenged, giving us the necessary funding to keep up our Clean Communities programs” added Mayor Pikolycky.
