CROCHET WORKSHOP AT WOODBINE BRANCH OF CMC LIBRARY

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Cape May County Library will be holding a two-day beginners crochet workshop at the Woodbine Branch, located at 800 Monroe Street, Woodbine, on Saturday, March 15 and Saturday, March 22, 2014, both from 10 am to noon.

Students will learn different stitches and how to read patterns during this workshop. This class is strongly recommended as a prerequisite for students who have no previous experience crocheting and wish to attend the more intermediate crotchet workshops offered by the Cape May County Library.

The presenter, Jennifer Bolton, learned to crochet from her grandmother, and hopes to pass on the tradition to her three girls. Jennifer has earned a degree in Fine Arts from Montgomery College.
