WOODBINE IN LINE TO RECEIVE \$584,131 FOR AIRPORT INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Woodbine Municipal Airport has received word from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Division of Aeronautics, that it is being offered an Airport Improvement Aid grant in the amount of \$584,131 for the construction of a new apron for additional aircraft parking and the ability to construct the necessary infrastructure for future T-hangar site work development. It also includes a connector taxiway extending from the new apron to an existing apron next to runway 12-30.

“This puts our general aviation airport into a state-of-the-art position for providing the necessary facilities for both fixed-base and transient aircraft,” noted Mayor Pikolycky. “Without the support of the Department of Transportation, projects such as these would not be economically feasible.”
