Learn to make simple wire wrapped loops and join them together to create a one of a kind beaded bracelet with your choice of semi-precious gemstones or stunning Swarovski Crystals. You will also choose to attach either a lobster claw clasp, or make your own!

This class is intended for beginners/intermediate, but participants should come to class with standard jewelry making tools (kit available at Michael's) which includes the necessary pliers/cutters for jewelry. (Household tools are not recommended)

A \$12.00 non-refundable materials fee is due at registration. All participants must bring their own jewelry working tools (available at Michaels or any art supply store.) Household tools are not recommended.

Suzanne has lived in Cape May County for over 25 years and is an avid Sea Glass collector and Jewelry maker since she was 5 years old. She specializes in Sea Glass Jewelry, Wire Working Techniques, and Silversmithing. She enjoys teaching both beginners and intermediate classes.
