Learn to create a stunning Sea Glass pendant using Silver Plated wire. This technique is called a "border wrap" and can be used on Sea glass, Shells, Cabochons and large beads as well as many other things. It is a great "intermediate" Technique for those having basic Wire Working knowledge.

Presenter Suzanne McKeon has lived in Cape May County for over 25 years, and is an avid Sea Glass collector and Jewelry maker since she was 5 years old. She specializes in Sea Glass Jewelry, wire Working Techniques, and Silversmithing. She enjoys teaching both beginners, and intermediate classes.
