Instructor Michele Pasciullo will demonstrate how to attach colored glass to a terra cotta saucer using the direct method of mosaic.

Michele Pasciullo is a graphic designer with an AA from Cumberland County College. A member of Ocean City Fine Arts League, she's displayed and sold her work at local shops as well as given home parties and workshops.
