

**BOROUGH OF WOODBINE  
WORKSHOP MEETING**

**FEBRUARY 5, 2015  
7:30 P.M.**

Mayor Pikolycky called the Workshop Meeting to order and read the following statement, “Adequate notice of this meeting was provided in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act by notifying the Press and The Herald on January 20, 2015 and posting a copy of said notice on the Clerk’s bulletin board.”

Those present were: Mayor Pikolycky; Councilpersons Ortiz, Murray, Bennett, Perez, Benson and Cruz . Also present were: Richard Tonetta, Borough Solicitor; and Lisa Garrison, Borough Clerk.

Mayor Pikolycky called for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Unfinished Business –

Rabies Clinic – March 7, 2015 – 10:00 am – 12: 00 pm. Ms. Garrison indicated she has been advised there is currently a shortage of vaccine. She indicated her decision not to cancel or postpone the clinic at this time as she feels the vaccine may be replenished by March.

New Business

Municipal Court Credit Card Payments - Ms. Garrison and Mr. Tonetta updated Council on the status. Mr. Tonetta indicated he has prepared a resolution for Council’s review.

School Board Invitation - Mayor Pikolycky indicated email correspondence had been received advising no one would be available to attend. Mr. Tonetta advised Council they have the authority to execute and serve subpoenas over matters in its jurisdiction. Mayor and Council directed Mr. Tonetta to direct correspondence to the school again requesting their presence in order to review the request to reallocate their payment to cover their debt service payment.

Green Team- Ms. Garrison explained the purpose of the Green Team. Councilman Bennett indicated he is currently working on recruiting members for the Green Team.

Municipal Alliance Committee - Ms. Garrison indicated there are currently vacancies on the Municipal Alliance Committee and a resolution has been prepared for Council’s review to fill

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the vacancies. She further indicated in the future there may be a need to add additional members.

FEMA Generator Grant - Mayor Pikolycky indicated the Borough has received notice of an award in the amount of \$91,000 for a generator for the municipal building.

WVFD AFG Grant - Mayor Pikolycky indicated the Fire Department has submitted an Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$116,000 for air packs.

Routes 550 & 638 - Mayor Pikolycky indicated a kick off meeting had been held with the engineers and anticipates construction in the summer of fall.

League of Municipalities Mayor Lunch Legislative Summit - Mayor Pikolycky indicated it was mentioned at the lunch summit that Woodbine had been cited, in the Star Ledger, as the 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest tax rate in the state of New Jersey.

On motion of Councilman Cruz, seconded by Councilwoman Perez to adjourn the workshop meeting, unanimously carried.
