Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has awarded the Borough of Woodbine a recycling grant in the amount of \$1,515.

Nearly \$4.2 million was distributed in these grants statewide. Awards were based on 2005 municipal recycling statistics.
