Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine has received \$4646.93 from the State of New Jersey for a recycling grant.

The Recycling Enhancement Act, signed into law by Governor Jon Corzine in January, boosts the amount of grant money available to local governments by creating a recycling enhancement fund through a \$3-per-ton surcharge on trash taken to solid-waste disposal facilities, which are located in Upper/Woodbine.

Local governments receive 60% of the money the fund generates to help them enhance outreach and compliance efforts. The balance goes for county garbage and household hazardous-waste collection programs and state promotional efforts.

“We are pleased with these fruits from Woodbine’s on-going recycling efforts and will be using these finds to continue to keep our costs down on trash disposal,” concluded Mayor Pikolycky.
