### **WOODBINE BOROUGH AWARDS CONTRACT ON \$156,000 DOT PROJECT**

**Woodbine**--Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that Woodbine Borough Council, at its April 17 meeting, awarded a contract in the amount of \$156,641.70 to SMB Paving, LLC, of Deptford, NJ, for a road reconstruction project reconstructing/resurfacing portions of Franklin Street and Clay Street. Major components of the completed project include roadway construction, roadway resurfacing, concrete curb, concrete gutter, as well as topsoil and seed restoration.

Bids received for this project were: SMB Paving, LLC, Deptford \$156,641.70; Jerry & Son Excavating, Inc., Mays Landing \$184,386; WECO Construction, Inc., Egg Harbor Township \$220,990.50; GWP Enterprises, Inc., Franklinville \$444,531.50; Haskell Site Work, LLC, West Creek \$205,860; American Asphalt Co., Inc., W. Collingswood Heights \$264,957.35.

The New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid program had awarded the Borough of Woodbine a grant for this project.

This project will be an extension of previous DOT Local Aid projects. Both Clay Street and Franklin Street are immediately adjacent to the proposed third phase of the Washington Avenue streetscape project. Franklin and Clay are busy routes adjacent to the commercial district and provide access from the adjoining residential neighborhoods, serving as major access routes between a residential zone and the town center.

"We expect construction to begin in approximately 30 days," said Mayor Pikolycky, "As always, I want to thank the Department of Transportation for supporting us by making such funds available to maintain our good road network conditions."
