WOODBINE HOLDS PUBLIC HEARING MAY 21

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that the Borough of Woodbine will hold a Public Hearing on May 21, at 3:30 p.m., at the Borough Hall, 501 Washington Avenue, concerning the performance and status of activities relating to implementation of its Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program for the purpose of railroad track reconstruction south of the Route 550 railroad trestle bridge, construction of a train station platform, and construction of a parking area. The purpose of this project is to add tourism to our community.

Interested parties are invited to attend this Hearing.
