### **WOODBINE STUDENT GOVERNMENT DAY TO BE COMBINED WITH ARBOR/EARTH DAY AND LAW DAY**

**Woodbine**—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that as Student Government Day for Woodbine Elementary School's current eighth graders will be held on April 30, 2007, (the Eve of Law Day), the annual Arbor/Earth Day Commemoration will also include references to Law Day.
