SHORE ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES OFFERS REDUCED SPAY/NEUTER FOR QUALIFYING WOODBINE RESIDENTS

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky is pleased to announce that Shore Animal Control, the Borough of Woodbine's Animal Control Services, will be accepting applications for the State spay/neuter program in the months of February and March. For residents who qualify, the cost will be \$10 for the surgery. Proof of rabies vaccination is required. Both dogs and cats are included under this program.

To qualify for this program, the owner must be on at least one of the following: Food stamps, SSI, ADC, Welfare, PAAD, Rental Assistance, Lifeline, Tenants Lifeline Assistance, or Medicaid.

Even those NOT on any of the above may qualify for a low-cost surgery for their pet at a reduced price.

“As we approach both our March 16 rabies clinic and the March 31 deadline for licensing of animals, I want to remind residents that there is a reduced licensing fee for spayed/neutered dogs,” added Mayor Pikolycky. “Please take advantage of these cost-saving programs.”
